Dress Code: Students who are new to the academy should be aware of the dress code for the various classes.

Acro - Bodysuit, tan convertible tights and bare feet (**NO street wear**).

Ballet:

Girls Pre Ballet and Pre Primary levels - pink bodysuit, pink tights, and pink leather ballet slippers. **All other Ballet levels** black bodysuit, pink tights, and pink ballet slippers.

Boys Junior Levels - tight fitting plain white T-shirt, black shorts or fitted dance pants, and black ballet slippers.

Boys Senior Levels - grey or black tights, fitted plain white tank top or T-shirt, black ballet shoes.

Special Training Ballet Junior Division to Intermediate & Advanced - blue tank leotard #3560 with pink seamless tights.

Junior Division must wear pink leather ballet slippers. All other special training levels must wear principal canvas ballet shoes.

General Level Jazz, Contemporary, Lyrical and Tap - students may wear any neat appropriate fitted "dance" attire with footwear being black jazz oxfords for jazz, beige foot paws for Contemporary and Lyrical and black tap shoes with rubber soles for tap (**NO street wear**).

Competition Jazz - Girls Pre Comp, Mini Comp, Comp 1, 2 & 3; black leotard style #3353 & #3354, tan tights, tan Bloch elasta bootie jazz shoes and hair in a bun (**NO street wear**). Academy Jazz, Comp 4, 5, 6, 7 & 8; black crop top style #3912 & #3913, black shorts, tan Bloch elasta bootie jazz shoes and hair in a bun (**NO street wear**).

All boys levels wear black shorts, plain white tank top or T-shirt (**NO street wear**) and Bloch elasta bootie jazz shoes.

Competition Tap - Girls Pre Comp, Comp 1, 2 & 3; black leotard style #3353 & #3354, tan tights and Pre Comp & Comp 1 beige Bloch buckle tap shoes with rubber soles (S0302G), Comp 2 black Bloch lace up tap shoes with rubber soles (S0301) and hair in a bun (**NO street wear**). Comp 4, 5, 6 & 7; black crop top style #3912 & 3913, black shorts and black lace up SoDanca Pro Tap Shoes TA800 with rubber soles and hair in a bun (**NO street wear**).

All boys levels wear black shorts, white tank top or T-shirt (**NO street wear**) and black lace up SoDanca tap shoes.

Hip Hop - Students may wear sweatpants (**NO jeans, cargos or skirts**), tank top or T-shirt, hoodies optional and indoor black and white high top converse shoes (available at most shoe stores - **NO street shoes**).
